

VIDDO.com cookie policy

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files containing a string of characters that can be placed on your computer or mobile device that uniquely identify your browser or device.

Cookies allow a site or services to know if your computer or device has visited that site or service before. Cookies can then be used to help understand how the site or service is being used, help you navigate between pages efficiently, help remember your preferences, and generally improve your browsing experience. Cookies can also help ensure marketing you see online is more relevant to you and your interests.

What types of cookies does VIDDO.com use?

VIDDO.com uses Session cookies and Performance cookies. You can find out more about each cookie category below.

1. **Session cookies.**

A cookie that is erased when the user closes the Web browser. The session cookie is stored in temporary memory and is not retained after the browser is closed. Session cookies do not collect information from the user's computer. They typically will store information in the form of a session identification that does not personally identify the user.

2. **Performance Cookies.** These cookies collect information about how you have used the Service, for example, information related to the unique username you have provided, so that less strain is placed on our backend infrastructure. These cookies may also be used to allow us to know that you have logged in so that we can serve you fresher content than a user who has never logged in. We also use cookies to track aggregate Service usage and experiment with new features and changes on the Service. The information collected is used to improve how the Service works.

How long will cookies stay on my device?

The length of time a cookie will stay on your computer or mobile device depends on whether it is a "persistent" or "session" cookie. Session cookies will only stay on your device until you stop browsing. Persistent cookies stay on your computer or mobile device until they expire or are deleted. VIDDO.com only uses session cookies as such.

First and third party cookies

First-party cookies are cookies that belong to VIDDO.com, third-party cookies are cookies that another party places on your device through our Service. Third-party cookies may be placed on your device by someone providing a service for VIDDO.com, for example to help us understand how our service is being used.

How to control and delete cookies

You can delete cookies in your browser any time, or stop receiving them altogether. This is a feature that you can use set in your browser. Note that if you set your browser to disable cookies, you may not be able to access certain parts of our site and other parts of our site may not work properly.
